Peter J. Hill is one of the country's leading traditional Australian equine and landscape artists and has sold paintings around the world. A bushie from way back Peter began painting when he was 19 years old and is completely self taught. His artwork today reflects his life as a Stockman, Shearer, Station-Hand, Buffalo and Crocodile Hunter. Peter's Paintings are distinguished by special observations of his subject which allows him to achieve a realism which reflects a sensitivity and respect for the rural countryside as well as the Australian Outback.

This will be the 5th year that Peter will present the "2006 Supreme Champion Led Horse" at the Pura Milk Gold Coast Show with another of his original paintings valued at \$5000. "It's a great honour to be part of the Centenary Show and I wanted to present a painting this year that reflected an image of the time of our first show. I hope that my painting "*The Mail must go through*" achieves that." said Peter.
